- ^a There is no minimum age for testing by FeLV Antigen ELISA. The test is not interfered with by FeLV vaccination. It does not distinguish between transient and persistent viremia (positives should be re-tested in 16 weeks).
- ^b Note: the AAFP recommends confirming FIV ELISA positive samples by an alternate serological (antibody) method such as Western Blot (test code WBFIV) or FIV IFA (test code FIVIFA). Maternal antibody may be present in uninfected kittens younger than 6 months of age. Cats vaccinated with FIV vaccine will be positive on any serologic test as early as 28 days post vaccination and stay positive for at least 1 year. In serologically positive cats that have been vaccinated or have an unknown vaccination history, an FIV RealPCR test (test code FIVR) should be considered to help identify FIV-infected cats.
